

How You Can Help.....

Much has already been done to get these children off the streets and into a safe and nurturing environment, but ***much still needs to be done.***

The land has been purchased, and the orphanage and guest house have been built, all through personal investment. However, in order to meet the day to day expenses of caring for these children and in order to be able to help more children, ***your help is much needed.***

Approximately **\$3,000 per month** is needed to provide housing and education for the children.

The current cost to provide a safe environment, including the daily costs of food, shelter, medical care, etc. for one child is approximately **\$50 per month.**

Since we are committed to providing the children with a good Christian education, there is also an additional **\$15 per month** needed for the education of each child.

This opportunity will mean that when the children are grown, they will have the opportunity for further education in order to have good jobs and provide for themselves.



These costs only provide for the basic needs of these children. However, because of the corruption of the government and customs regulations, monetary donations are truly the best way that you can help. Sending of individual gift items rarely make it to the children.

The Mary Diana Samuel Foundation was founded in 1998 to help the destitute and to

propagate the Gospel of Jesus Christ to unreached corners of the world. Mary Diana Samuel was the second daughter of Aaron and Nalini Samuel. She was precocious in her understanding of the Bible. Her capstone was that she would have the Lord Jesus as her spouse and that she would have countless children all around the world. That vision came to an abrupt halt when she was killed in an automobile accident in 1995 at the age of twelve. The family continues to bear deep scars from that event. However, our Lord in a revelation, advised us that scars should be turned into stars.

Our motto is, *"Our God has infinite resources and what we donate on earth for the Name of Jesus Christ will yield abundant blessings"*.

Who We Are.....

The poor of India form a vicious cycle of degradation and poverty. The most vulnerable amongst these are the girls. Daily there are girls abandoned, aborted, or sold to unscrupulous merchants who use them in human trafficking. These precious children are created in the image of God, and it is our privilege to offer them an alternative through Christ.

The Mary Diana Samuel Foundation is privileged to **currently shelter thirty eight girls and two boys who have been rescued from the unconscionable fate that would have befallen these precious children who are created in the image of God.** We are providing them food, shelter, a Christian education, and health care in a Christ centered home. We are blessed with full time workers who have sacrificed lucrative jobs to care for these children. **With your help, more can be done.** We have the space to care for up to 120 children in a nurturing Christian environment. Currently plans are underway to add more children within a few months.

Finding good workers is a problem. Please pray that God will send the right people and for the finances needed to increase the number of children that are served.

Nearly \$300,000 of personal investment by Dr. Samuel has already been made to bring this dream to fruition. However, we affirm without hesitation that all material wealth is a gift from the Triune God, and the privileged beneficiaries of His Blessing should disperse to those in need.

One goal is complete transparency. A guest house has been built for donors to see and witness first hand the Grace that our Lord has provided through you.
